General Rules and Regulations

- The first game begins at 7pm (players to check in no later than 6:30pm). Please arrive no later than 6:30pm. It is a Friday night this year, and you'll need to get in line to get shoes and prepare to bowl!
- There will be 2 games (lanes are available to us from 7pm-9pm). Awards and prizes will be distributed by 9:15pm.
- The Tournament is rain or shine – it's indoors! If there is inclement weather that affects the event, info will be posted on the website: www.davekrache.com and Facebook: www.facebook.com/davekrache
- Pizza, salad, and fountain drinks will be supplied to players only – not family members of participants who are not one of the registered team members. You will have the opportunity to purchase additional food and drinks if you would like. Please abide by this, as we will run out of food if non-registered guests eat the food intended for registered players.
- Please bring your bowling shoes and bowling balls if you have them! If you don't have shoes, that's okay - Shoe rental is included with registration fee.
- Be creative with your team name! Dress up in a theme, if you'd like! Who knows – there may be awards!
- We are playing tournament style – you are competing against every time.
- You may be asking, "Will teams of 4 and teams of 6 all compete for the same awards?" The answer is YES! This year, the team who has the highest AVERAGE score overall will determine which team wins. There will be some fun chances to, oh, bend the rules a bit. Bring some cash or debit/credit cards and let's have some fun! (Specific additional rules will be provided at the event)
- The Foundation has the right to refuse a person from participating for any reason.
- If the form is not completed by the time tournament play starts and payment received in full by April 1, the team may not play.
- As long as page 1 is completed of this form, and payment is received by April 1, waivers may be completed at the event: Team captains will be responsible for getting this information and turning it in at registration.
- Patronize your sponsors and the bowling alley! They've helped to make it a great tournament!
- Remember this is a tournament for FUN! Healthy competition is great, but let's not get anyone arrested, okay? We ask that no one come and take this too seriously. 😊
