THE YEAR IN REVIEW

There's good news and there's bad news.

The good news is that in a post-pandemic era, sports are back and better than ever! The bad news is that they also seem more expensive than ever.

When a household budget is already tight and parents can barely pay the necessities, their kids are told they can't play sports because the money just isn't there. The DKF was approached by local high schools for support for their sports programs, as many students could not afford the fees to play. In one case, a high school reports more than 80% of their students qualifying for free or reduced school lunches. It's no wonder these families need support for their children to play sports.
